

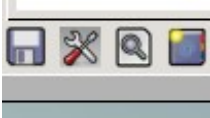
Welcome to OWB manual

OWB (Origyn web browser) is an open-source web browser based on [Webkit](#) (Apple Inc project).

This manual is meant for [AROS](#) (AROS Research Operating System) It will not go into detail about how to use a web browser, only focus on [OWB-AROS](#) specific features.

Settings

Look down left in OWB window, you will see 4 icons.

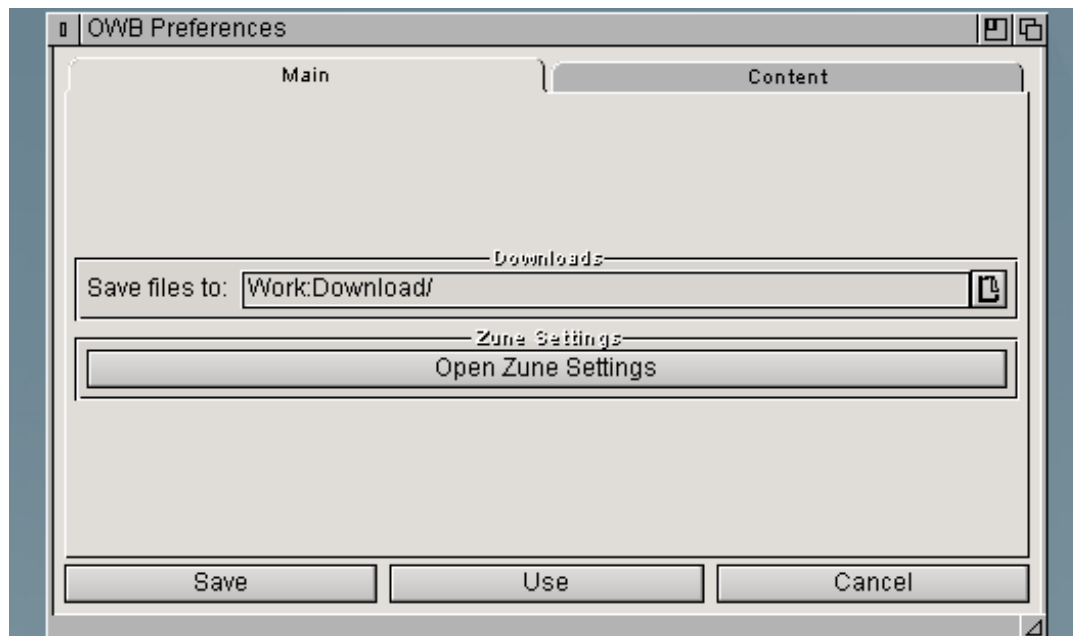


The icon with a disk, opens the download manager. From there you can cancel and clear files.

The icon that show tools, are the one to click on to configure OWB.

The icon to the right of tools icon you can search for text inside a page.

The last icon to the right opens bookmark manager.



In main tab you can set your download location (default RAM:T/)

In Content you can set default fonts, disable, enable java-script etc. You can also configure Zune ([mui clone](#)) with “open Zune settings”.

Fonts

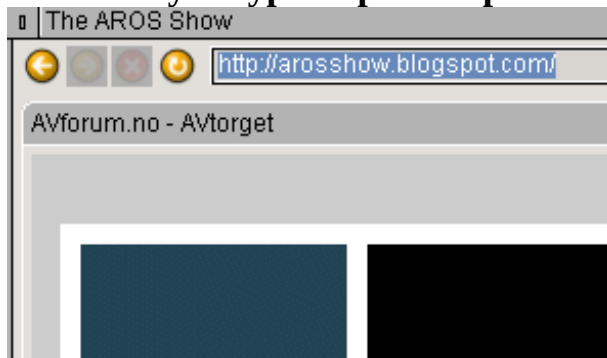
With default Fonts, some web pages will not display Fonts correct. It is recommended that you install [mswebcorefonts](#). You have to put all the .ttf Fonts in SYS:Fonts/TrueType/. This Font pack can not be included in OWB because of license. You will find them on Internet. When installed, OWB will automatic make use of them.

Location bar

Click inside location bar and type any URL you like, then press enter to go to location.

It is possible to copy and paste URLs into Location Bar. You can also double click or mark the Location Bar, to select the URL that is already there.

The URL you type or paste replaces any text already in the Location Bar.



Searching the web

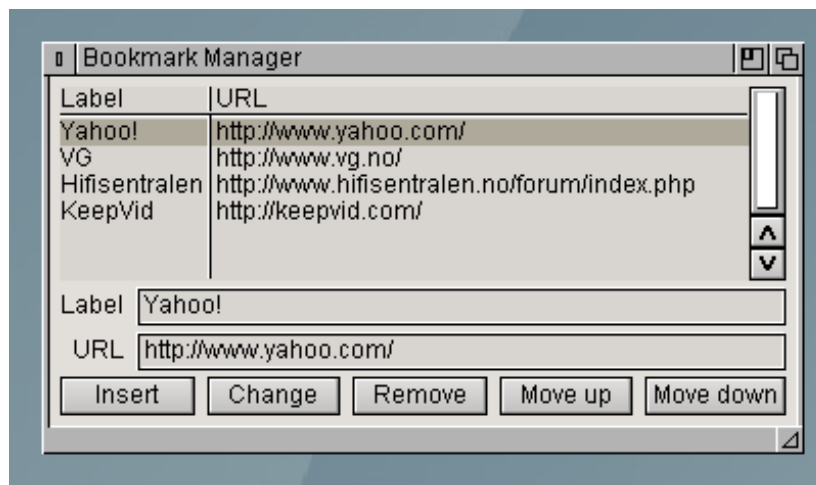
On the right side of location bar you will see a field where you can search the web (Google search). Type whatever you want to search for and hit enter.

Bookmark manager

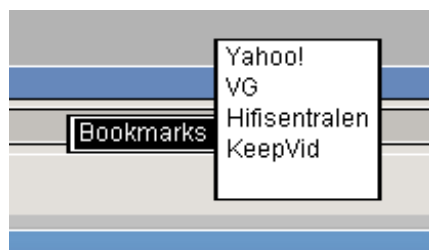
To bookmark a page right click on top of tab, and you get a menu to select “bookmark this tab”.



From there you can insert, change, remove and sort your bookmarks.



After bookmarks are created you can right click on location bar and your bookmarks will pop up.



Tabs

Right click on top of tabs and you will get a menu where you can open and close tabs. Look at the “Alta vista picture” to get an idea of how it looks like.

Keyboard shortcuts

F1 – go back, **F2 – go forward**, **F3 - zoom in page**, **F4 – zoom out page**, **Ctrl+t – open new tab**, **Ctrl+w – close active tab**

F12 or amiga (win)+c – copy

F12 or amiga (win)+x – cut

F12 or amiga (win)+v – paste
